Spins

Skated on 1/2 ice surface

Skaters may compete at their current FS test level or one level higher. Pre-Juvenile through Senior spin requirements are taken from USFSA Rules TR 42.03-42.12.

Connecting steps may be used but will have no effect on scoring.

One foot spin, back spin, sit spin

Preliminary: 1 min

One foot spin, front to back spin, camel spin

Compulsory Moves

Skated on 1/2 ice surface

Eligibility requirements are the same as Free Skating. Elements may be skated in any order.

Beginner: 1 min

Bunny hops (two in a row), lunge, waltz jump, forward spiral, one foot spin, min 3 revs.

PrePreliminary: 1 min

Forward outside spiral, Loop jump, Salchow, single/single jump combination, (no axels) Scratch spin Min 3 revs

Preliminary: 1 min 30 sec

Flip jump, single-single jump (axel is considered a single jump), sit-spin, forward spiral, Straight line step sequence.

PreJuvenile: 1 min

Lutz jump; single-single jump (must include loop); combination spin, one change of position, no change of foot; backward spiral, Straight line step sequence.

Adult Bronze: 1 min

Waltz jump, Salchow, one foot spin, forward spiral.

Adult Silver: 1 min 30 sec

Flip, toe loop, single-single (no axels), sit spin, Straight line step sequence.

Adult Gold: 1 min 30 sec

Lutz, loop, single-single (axel is considered single jump), combination spin, one change of position, no change of foot; Straight line step sequence.

Basic Skills Events

Skated on 1/2 ice surface

Entrants in Basic Skills are not permitted to skate in any other events.

Compulsory Moves:

Demonstrators will be provided.

Skaters will remain on the ice in between elements during this event.

Snowplow Sam: Snow plow stop in place, backward marching, 2 foot glide, 2 foot hop.

Basic 1 & 2: Two foot glide, backwards swizzles, forward two foot sways, moving snowplow stop.

Basic 3 & 4: Forward stroking, one foot snowplow stop, forward two foot sways, backward one foot glides, right and left.

Basic 5 & 6: Forward outside 3 turn, right and left, lunge, two foot spin.

Free Skating:

Snowplow Sam: March in place, two foot glide and dip, backward wiggles, two foot hop.

Basic 1 & 2: Glide forward and dip, moving snowplow stop, forward two foot swizzles, backward wiggles, one foot glide, right and left.

Basic 3 & 4: Forward stroking, forward crossovers both directions, backward one foot swizzles on circle, two foot spin.

Basic 5 & 6: Backward stroking, backward crossovers both directions, forward spiral, bunny hop, hockey stop.

Showcase & Interpretive Events

Eligibility requirements are the same as Free Skating.

Showcase: Skater provides own music. Music may include vocals. Programs may include one hand held prop (not to be set down).

Interpretive: Music will be provided by Nashville Figure Skating Club.
