Dear Skaters and Parents,

Welcome to the 2010-2011 skating season. This year will be an especially exciting as the Nashville FSC hosts the Eastern Great Lakes Regional Championships on October 8 – 12, 2010.

Attached you will find a Nashville FSC membership form for 2010-2011. Please read everything carefully and keep in mind that you need to be a current member in good standing in order to test, to compete in any USFS competitions and to participate in any sanctioned shows or exhibitions.

**Your club membership begins July 1, 2010 and ends June 30, 2011. All forms must be completely filled out and your membership fee paid in full. Current members not renewing their membership before August 1<sup>st</sup> will be assessed an additional \$25 application-processing fee.**

In addition to membership fees, **members are required to have an adult work a minimum of 4 – 8 hours at each Nashville FSC hosted competition as outlined in the membership categories summary table.** Completion of the work hours is required to remain a member in good standing. Should you choose not to complete the required work hours, we will require an additional payment at the rate of \$15/hour for unfulfilled hours. Members not completing work hours or making payment for them will not be in good standing and will be ineligible to test or compete. Competitive skaters are required to work 2 hours per NFSC hosted competition.

**All coaches except those under age 16 or Basic Skills instructors engaged only in group lessons must also be USFS members and are required to register with US Figure Skating to verify liability insurance and provide information for a required background check.** Registration is necessary to participate in all non-qualifying and qualifying competitions and test sessions.

Dear Skaters, Parents, Coaches and Friends of the Nashville FSC,

The Nashville FSC needs **every** member to contribute to the success of our Club by donating both time and talent. Our Club is managed solely by members who volunteer. We cannot successfully host test sessions, competitions, exhibitions, social events, and training camps without your volunteer help. Most clubs now require service hours and/or additional fees as a condition of membership.

Please review this list of resource needs, then submit this form with your membership application/renewal. Please keep in mind this skating year there are two competitions the adult member and the competitive skater **must** give volunteer hours to remain member in good standing.

Volunteering is a wonderful way to meet other club members, to give back to your club and to show full support of your child's sport. Thank you for your interest and support!

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### Competitions

**Hospitality:** Set up, maintain, serve meals, clean the judges suite and seek food donations. (food, utensils, tables, chairs).

**Registration:** Greet and check in skaters, coaches, and volunteers. Collect unpaid fees, distribute "goody bags", and sell practice ice, programs, results and other possible items.

**Runners:** Deliver competition results to the accountants, make appropriate copies, deliver to registration, awards and post.

**Competition Ice Monitors:** Check in and supervise skaters rink side before each event. Coordinate with the competition chair, referee and announcer.

**Practice Ice Monitors:** Check in skaters and work the practice ice table selling additional practice ice..

**Announcers:** Introduce the event and skaters over the public address system.

**Music:** Play skaters' music and time warm-ups.

**Transportation:** Drive officials. This includes picking up and dropping off from both the airport and hotel.

**Awards:** Announce medalists and present awards throughout the competition. Bag and identify all unclaimed medals and forward to registration.

**Coaches Hospitality:** Plan meals, purchase food/seek donations as needed, set up, maintain and clean up area.

**Set-up and Disassembly:** Erect, tear down judges stands, tables, chairs, vendors sites, registration, accounting and officials areas.

**Donations:** Solicit food, goody bag and/or monetary donations.

**Program:** Sell ads and produce program for printing.

### Communications

**Newsletter:** Contribute photos, feature articles, upcoming events, and competition results. Seek updated email addresses for delivery of newsletter and forward to the membership chair.

**Public Relations:** Submit competition information, feature stories to local newspapers, magazines and schools.

**Website:** Maintain and update; write copy and post information.

### Testing

**Hospitality:** Provide breakfast for the judges.

**Music:** Play skaters' music and time warm-ups.

**Runners:** Collect results from judges, copy and distribute copies and originals.

### IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS!

1. Please carefully read the membership categories before completing the application.
2. All members must pay their entire membership fee prior to submitting applications for competitions or testing. All fields must be completed for U.S. Figure Skating to accept registration.
3. All forms (Application and Volunteer Service Agreement) must be completed and returned.

<b>Membership Types</b>
<b>Junior Competitive Skater</b> Membership: 17 years or younger, members can compete, test and perform at USFSA sanctioned events. Includes one adult membership with voting rights. 8 adult volunteer hours per competition and 2 volunteer hours from the skater.
<b>Family Membership</b> Membership: Competitive skaters must be 17 years or younger, members can compete, test and perform at USFSA sanctioned events. Includes two adult membership with voting rights. 8 adult volunteer hours per competition per competitive skater not to exceed 24 hours per year and 2 volunteer hours from each competitive skater.
<b>Collegiate</b> Membership: Four year full membership for 4 years. Available to full time college students under age 26. Proof of full-time college/university attendance is required. Collegiate members must designate the Nashville FSC as their home club. Collegiate members are ineligible for any Nashville FSC monetary awards, scholarships, or financial assistance. Voting privileges. 8 adult volunteer hours per NFSC hosted competition.
<b>Senior Competitive Skater</b> Membership: Full skating membership available to adults 18 years and older who test and/or compete. Includes Club Ice, testing, competitions, exhibitions, special events, and social functions as well as Skating magazine and Newsletter, club directory, and coverage under USFS's sports accident insurance policy. Free membership for non-testing, non-competing spouse. Voting privileges. 8 adult volunteer hours per NFSC hosted competition.
<b>Associate</b> Membership: Available to non-competitive skaters. Non-competitive skaters 16 years or older who coach Nashville FSC members for tests, USFSA qualifying and non-qualifying events. May teach on Club Ice, exhibitions, special events, and social functions as well as Skating magazine and Newsletter, club directory, and coverage under USFS's sports accident insurance policy. Over 18 –years-old have voting privileges. Volunteer hours for coaches are 8 hours per NFSC hosted competition.
<b>Basic Skills</b> Memberships: For Basic 1-8 and Basic FS skaters. Skater can compete in USFS basic skills competitions, membership in Jr Club. 8 adult volunteer hours per NFSC hosted competition.

**Coaches:** Please note that for coaches over the age of 18 it is a requirement of the USFSA that you are registered with USFSA as a coach, have had a background check and are a club member in good standing with your local club.
